McKay Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program

What is the McKay Scholarship?

- Established in 2000, this program was designed to help students with disabilities in choosing another public school or eligible private school to accommodate their academic, social, and environmental needs.

Who is eligible?

- Students enrolled in a Florida public school for **both** the October and February FTE surveys during the prior school year in grades Pre-K to 12.

- Students who have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) from the public school

What are the options?

- Request a different public school within your district
- Request a public school in an adjacent school district **or**
- Receive a scholarship for your child to attend a participating private school
