(Please note: GED has been renamed Adult General Education (AGE)).

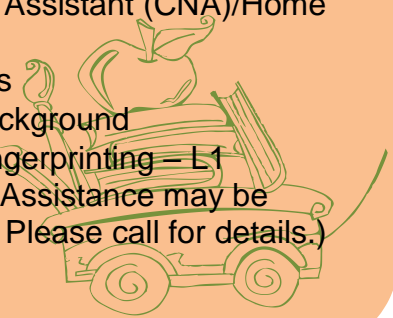

Tell me more about the classes at Sumter Adult Education Center

1. Adult General Education (AGE formally known as GED) and Adult Basic Education (ABE)
 - Registration: \$45 per semester for all Florida Residents. Applicants must provide Social Security card and 2 proofs of residency (Nonresidents call for fee.)
 - Fee (cash or money order) covers AGE/ABE classes at sites listed on previously.
 - Fee includes
 - TABE test
 - AGE Pre-Test
 - AGE Study Guide (after 30 hours of instruction)
2. English for Speakers of Other Languages(ESOL)/Adult General Education (AGE)/Adult Basic Education (ABE)
 - Registration: \$45 per semester for all Florida Residents. Applicants must provide Social Security card and 2 proofs of residency (Nonresidents call for fee.)
 - Fee (cash or money order) covers AGE/ABE classes at sites listed on previously.
 - Fee includes
 - TABE test
 - GED Pre-Test
 - GED Study Guide (after 30 hours of instruction)
3. Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)/Home Health Aide
 - \$460 Class
 - \$68.25 Background
 - \$15.00 Fingerprinting – L1 (Financial Assistance may be available. Please call for details.)



What are Career Pathways Programs?

The Career Pathway program helps prepare students for career interests that require technical and educational preparation for demanding jobs. Students are provided guidance and counseling to achieve full certification in career fields that directly align with the candidate's interest and abilities.
