

2011-2012 PROMOTION CRITERIA FOR GRADES K-5

KINDERGARTEN PROMOTION CRITERIA

- Achieving a 70 or higher for the year in reading course work designated as on grade level
- Scoring at the 45th national percentile or higher on the SAT 10 in Total Reading
- Achieving a 70 or higher for the year in math course work designated as on grade level

1st & 2nd GRADES PROMOTION CRITERIA

Students will be required to attain two out of the three criteria for promotion in Reading:

- Mastering 70% or more of the Reading Next Generation Sunshine State Standards
- Achieving a 70 or better for the year in reading and be designated as on grade level
- Scoring at the 45th national percentile or higher on the SAT 10 in Reading Comprehension

AND

Students will be required to attain two out of the three criteria for promotion in Math:

- Mastering 70% or more of the Math Next Generation Sunshine State Standards
- Achieving a 70 or better for the year in math and be designated as on grade level
- Scoring at the 45th national percentile or higher on the SAT 10 in Total Math

3rd, 4th and 5th GRADES PROMOTION CRITERIA

The following shall be considered by the instructional staff before a student is promoted:

- Made satisfactory progress in Reading for student's grade level assignment as identified in the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards
- Made satisfactory progress in Language Arts for student's grade level assignment as identified in the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards
- Made satisfactory progress in Mathematics for student's grade level assignment as identified in the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards
- Made satisfactory progress in Science for student's grade level assignment as identified in the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards
- Made satisfactory progress in Process Writing
- Made satisfactory progress based on school, district and state assessments
- Made satisfactory progress in classroom and homework
