



Guidelines for the Return of Volunteers

Our country, our state, our county, and our schools have been drastically affected by the COVID-19 Pandemic. We are working with our local and state health officials to provide the healthiest and safest learning environment for our students and staff. We are asking that the adults work with the district and understand that the district will be limiting outside visitors, including parents, mentors, volunteers and others to start school. As the year progresses, the district will enter into and out of different phases based on the status of the pandemic.

REOPEN – PHASE 1

Timeline: Beginning the first nine weeks, August 24, 2020

No outside visitors other than staff are allowed on campus. Parents meetings are conducted by phone, computer or if in person, all wear a face covering and have temperatures checked.

RECOVER – PHASE 2

Timeline: Beginning the second nine weeks, October 28, 2020

Essential volunteers return: mentors with currently assigned students such as Take Stock in Children, Big Brothers Big Sisters and New Covenant Methodist. All sign in through the Raptor system and have temperatures checked in the front office. Face coverings are required within six feet of others. Volunteers will be assigned to one cohort of students or child. Limited campus movement is required. Any sign of sickness and the adult will be asked to leave campus.

REVITALIZE – PHASE 3

Timeline: TBD

All volunteers return. All sign in through the Raptor system and have temperatures checked in the front office. Face coverings are recommended. Limited campus movement is recommended. Any sign of sickness and the adult will be asked to leave.
