Hiring Highlights

All newly hired teachers and psychologists are placed on the salary level reflective of their years of satisfactory experience.

Evidence of a higher base salary from a previous employer and two most recent evaluations, will result in a higher placement as indicated on the range not to exceed a current employee's salary at the same experience level. Until verification of the preceding is received, the employee will be paid at the lowest salary for the experience level; if verification is not received within ninety days from date of employment, the employee will remain at the lowest level until the following year.

Teaching and psychologist experience must be in a Public School System (K-16) or in a regionally accredited private school (K-16).

Career and Technical Education teachers working under a district-issued certificate may be awarded up to ten years of experience specifically related to their teaching assignment, above the work experience required for certification.

Speech Language Pathologists may be awarded up to ten years of non-school, D.O.H. licensed experience specifically related to speech pathology.

Experience for United States military service may be counted for up to four years.

A year's teaching or psychologist experience must include at least ninety-nine (99) days active duty during a school year.

Progression to a higher pay level is not automatic from one employment year to the next. The district uses a performance based pay plan for all teachers and psychologists.
