SPRING 2019 SCHOLARSHIPS

1) Paul S. Mills Scholarship - \$1,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: March 30, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a full or part-time student enrolled or accepted into an undergraduate college or university program.
- B) Be pursuing a course of study in a financial service field.

2) Boule Foundation Scholarship - \$4,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Possess a minimum cumulative GPA of a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- B) Be graduating from high school in the spring of 2019 and entering college as a Full-Time Freshmen in the Fall of 2019 and be of African-American descent.

3) Kezian Science Scholarship - \$1,200 - 1 Award (Deadline: March 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be at least 18 years of age.
- B) Be attending a College or University in the Fall of 2019

4) Enterprise Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: March 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) You must be at least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US.
- B) You must be a legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.

5) You Deserve It Scholarship - \$1,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: March 29, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) You must be a resident of any of the 50 United States, District of Columbia or US Territories
- B) You must be 16 years of age or older and be enrolled in college or registered in a high school.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently in high school or college.
- B) Be attending a College or University in the Fall of 2019

7) Intel ISEF Scholarship Awards - \$75,000 - 600 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2019)

- B) Not have reached age 20 on or before May 1 preceding the Intel ISEF.

8) National Dairy Shrine Scholarships - \$3,000 - 42 Awards (Deadline: April 15, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a high school senior planning to enter a four-year-college or university with intent to major in Dairy/Animal Science with a Communications emphasis or Agricultural Journalism with a Dairy/Animal Science emphasis.

9) Len Assante Scholarship Fund - \$5,000 – 10 Awards (Deadline: April 15, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

B) Be enrolled in a program that is groundwater industry-related, such as hydrogeology, water resource management, water well construction and supply, geology, etc.

B) Plan on taking courses related to Culinary Arts, Baking/Pastry or Hospitality.
